Prayer and meditation are always essential in gaining a better understanding of God's Word and its relevance to your life and situation.

UNIT I: Confirmed by Power Over Death

All lessons this month confirms Jesus' deity by His power over death

WEEK 3- Jesus Brings Lazarus Back to Life : This lesson shows how some people believed while others tried to kill Jesus because Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead.

WEEK 4- Jesus Is Crucified: This lesson focuses on the crucifixion of Jesus Christ

Week 5-The Resurrection of Jesus (Easter): This lesson focuses on the resurrection of Jesus Christ and the response of those who witnessed his resurrection

LESSON REVIEW

- 1. What does it mean to have doubt? It means to be unsure of something or have questions about the truth.
- 2. Is there something that you have tried that was impossible for you to do?
- 3. Why did Jesus wait when He got the message that Lazarus was sick? He didn't want anyone to have any doubts that He is God and He has the power to do anything.
- 4. How did people know that Lazarus was dead? He was wrapped in cloths and placed in the tomb.
- 5. Who is the only one who has power over death? God/Jesus.
- 6. Do you think Jesus' life began as a baby in the manger? No, Jesus is God, He was in heaven before He came down to earth as a baby.
- 7. What happened when Jesus called for Lazarus to come out? Lazarus came forth with his hands and feet still bound in graveclothes
- 8. How did Mary and Martha respond when Lazarus came forth? They were happy that Jesus had brought their brother back to life.
