Prayer and meditation are always essential in gaining a better understanding of God's Word and its relevance to your life and situation.

April 2024 UNIT II: Confirmed by Mighty Miracles

All lessons this month will focus on how Jesus' deity is confirmed by His miraculous works

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DATE OF LESSON: April 7, 2024 **LESSON TITLE:** Jesus' First Miracle

LESSON TEXT: John 2:1-12

RELATED SCRIPTURES: John 1:35-51; 20:26-31

GOLDEN TEXT: "This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested

forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him" (John 2:11)

TARGET AGE GROUP: This week's discussion is taken from the **Adult Bible Class** book.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. In which town do we find Jesus and His disciples on this occasion, and who was already there (John2:1)?
- 2. What does Jesus' attendance of the wedding tell us about Him?
- 3. Why was the shortage of wine of such momentous concern?
- 4. Who was the person who reported the problem to Jesus, and why might it have been of special concern to her?
- 5. How did Mary respond to what Jesus said to her?
- 6. Why did the servants' obedience to Jesus' instructions require faith?
- 7. What was the response of the master of ceremonies when he tasted the wine?
- 8. What does John indicate was the purpose of Jesus' miracles (cf 20:30-31)?
- 9. How does the miracle of Cana fit into that purpose?
- 10. What response came from the disciples of Jesus? What response should come from us?

that believeth" (Mark 9:23)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What did Jesus and the three disciples encounter when they came down the mountain?
- 2. What happened when Jesus asked the scribes what they were discussing with His disciples?
- 3. How did the father describe his son's actions, and to what did he attribute it?
- 4. What exasperated Jesus about the whole situation?
- 5. What happened when the boy first saw Jesus?
- 6. What seemed to have happened to the father's faith? Why?
- 7. How do we hear this in his request to Jesus (Mark 9:22)?
- 8. Why did Jesus say "if thou canst believe" to the father (v. 23)?
- 9. What happened when Jesus commanded the demon to leave?
- 10. How did Jesus explain the disciples' inability to succeed?

- 2. Why did the Pharisees thing Jesus' disciples were breaking the Sabbath law?
- 3. Did Jesus and His disciples actually violate God's Sabbath law? Explain.
- 4. What was Jesus' point in citing the example of David and the tabernacle bread?
- 5. Who is the Lord of the Sabbath, and what does that mean?
- 6. Why did Jesus not wait until after the Sabbath to heal the man with withered hand?
- 7. Why were the Pharisees in Galilee?
- 8. How was Jesus keeping the Sabbath for good while the scribes and the Pharisees were keeping it for evil?
- 9. What principle about obedience did Jesus teach through His question to the scribes and Pharisees?
- 10. How is Jesus' Sabbath restoration of what was broken a picture of what is to come?

- 1. What was the focus of Jesus' ministry at this time?
- 2. Why did Jesus send the disciples ahead of Him?
- 3. Why can we say that the disciples were not really in danger?
- 4. Why were the disciples frightened when they saw Jesus approaching the boat?
- 5. What request did Peter make of Jesus? How did Jesus respond?
- 6. In what sense was Peter's faith "little" (Matthew 14:31)?
- 7. What happened as soon as Jesus and Peter reached the boat?
- 8. How did the disciples respond to what they had witnessed on the sea?
- 9. Who did the disciples proclaim Jesus to be?
- 10. How did the people of Gennesaret respond to Jesus' arrival there?
